Duane and Deanna began ministry together as Bible teachers in their local church and have been involved in teaching the Bible since 1961, which is also the year they married. They have three children and six grandchildren. For the past 16 years Duane has served as International Director of Missions for a large international ministry. Deanna assisted him, as well as led women's ministry. Preparations for large gospel celebrations included counselor training, schools of evangelism, youth rallies, speaking in schools, women's seminars, seminars for pastor's and wives, men's seminars and preaching in churches. This ministry has taken them to 67 countries sharing the gospel with well over 1 ½ million people.

Duane received his B.A. from Oklahoma City University and a M.A. from Tulsa University. Prior to going into full time ministry, he attended seminary in Fort Worth, TX. Duane has served two years as President of The Fellowship of Baptist World Ministries. This organization is an autonomous group of 37 ministries working all over the world.

Duane is also a member of the Oklahoma and National Conference of Southern Baptist Evangelists (COSBE).

Deanna attended Frank Phillips College, and Oklahoma City University. She has had training in Biblical counseling from the National Association of Nouthetic Counselors, June Hunt Counseling Ministry, Institute of Biblical Counselors, and Henry Brandt Counseling Ministries.
