## El Salvador, Central America





The land of faithful Christians, lush jungles, and tall volcanoes

There were 165 Spanish language Bibles given! Here are a few stories of the shared blessings. We gave two Thompson Chain Reference Bibles (18 total) at the end of each days seminar. Because of the expense of the this Bible the pastors rarely can afford this good study Bible. As we drew, each time the pastor receiving it would shout for joy and literally rush to the front amid cheers from the others. After one pastor's wife received a Bible, she shared that she had been praying for a Bible to give to her friend's husband who was in prison and had recently received Christ as his Savior. At Santa Anna, a frail elderly lady who served us every day by preparing and cleaning the church expected nothing from us. We had one Bible left after giving to the pastors and we were already in the vehicle to leave. We went back into the church to thank her for serving and we felt led to give her that last Bible. She took the Bible and hugged it to her bosom with tears of joy, thanking God.

The Bible seminars were also blessed. El Salvador is a religious country but, sad to say, many do not apply Scripture to their family living. Even the pastoral leadership is plagued with problems of adultery and legalism. In two of the three cities we taught, we were asked to teach one session on adultery. As we taught there there were several couples with tears as they had struggled through this problem of adultery. After one seminar our interpreter/coordinator, Ed Nerio, counseled a couple. We sensed a different attitude of all those attending the seminars this time. They were desperate for God's answers to the problems of families, both their own and in their churches One older single pastor, from the far northern area, cried as he thanked us for equipping him to help his church members. There were also missionaries from San Francisco, CA who videoed the seminar to use in their ministry. In San Miguel, the Baptist pastors told us they were planning to join together and teach all of their members this Family Seminar. Many made flash drives of both the materials and power points to use in teaching. THE LIGHT OF GOD'S WORD IS SPREADING INTO THE DARK CORNERS OF THIS EARTH! The pastors and wives repeatedly asked us to tell you "THANK YOU" for the great blessing you have given them. We want to thank the many country coordinators who did a great job this year. We are so blessed to work with such godly men and women.

## OUR REFLECTIONS ON MINTOR 2012 MISSIONS

- Through the Lord's leading, MINTOR was able to go literally to the ends of the earth with God's Word. For example, in Kenya we went to the end of a drivable road to Kitui where pastors came from at least 200 klms beyond Kitui.
- Through the Lord's leading, MINTOR reached into the far northeast region of India into areas which were formerly too dangerous. These pastors took God's Word over borders into areas where the gospel is forbidden.
- God is using modern technology through MINTOR to spread His Powerful Word into the darkest areas of the world. Many pastors were equipped with flash drives with Bible Study material and power point in their languages to spread His Word.
- The evil of this world in getting worse. We have been in areas this year where there was unbelievable violence, yet God has divinely protected us (2 Thes. 3:3). We have been near places where abortion is such a common thing that a whole city area is designated for it. If the women do not agree to abort, their lives are taken as well as the unborn child. We were in areas in Africa where the customs of female circumcision is practiced regularly to the physical and mental damage of young 13 and 14 year old girls. One pastor friend from Honduras had to leave his 1200 congregation church because the local gangs had threatened the life of his family including his grandchildren, if the church did not pay for protection to the gangs. Through MINTOR God is shining His Light of Jesus into these dark and sinful places. Psalm 119: 130a. II Cor. 4:6 *"For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.*
- Persecution of godly believers is a common reality in the world today. Satan is working harder than ever to destroy what God is doing in the lives of thousands, but God is victorious. I John 3:8b *"The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work."* We have seen that it is growing increasingly more difficult to be in full time ministry and we feel that a significant part of MINTOR is meeting special needs unique to encouraging and equipping those called. Acts 14: 21-22 *"They preached the good news in that city and won a large number of disciples. Then they returned to Lystra, Iconium and Antioch, strengthening the disciples and encouraging them to remain true to the faith."*
