We greet you in the loving

you are having a good summer.
After our intense
work in Africa, we have
taken time for a vacation
and some family time. We
had one of our Kenya coordinator/pastor and his wife
for 9 days in June. They are
teaching MINTOR Bible
Study materials to others in
Uganda. Next week we
keep grandkids for about 10
days. God is good!
We are now working on
preparation for El Salvador.
We plan on leaving Aug. 1
and returning around Aug.
21st. There has already
been much spiritual opposi-

tion to the work there so
please pray now as well as
while we are there. We
had problems with a money
transfer but finally it has
arrived. Then there are
problems with different
denominations not wanting
to work together. Pray
Psalm 133.1 “How good
and pleasant it is when
brothers live together in
unity.”.

A veteran missionary to El
Salvador recently said this:
“El Salvador is the second
most violent Spanish speak-
ing country in the world.
They average 16 murders a
day, usually by gangs. The
country is small as it is only
half the size of Mississippi.
They preach a prosperity gos-

pel.” So you can see the
needs are great and prayer
is much needed. “Who is it
