To our cherished Prayer Partners and Friends,

Two and a half months have flown by since we came back from Malawi. Now we are preparing to leave for Kenya and Uganda. Again we decided to work the two countries on the same trip to save on air fare. We have studied and worked on the third set of seminars and they are being translated now. This will be perhaps the most challenging of all missions because this time we will be teaching 4 seminars of the first series, 5 seminars of the second series, and 2 seminars of the third series.

Two of the seminars will be 3 days and the rest will be 2 days each. We want to give credit to the Lord for the wonderful pastors and Bible teachers who have invested in our lives. We also appreciate the many excellent programs like the Navigators and Bible Memory Association which helped ground us in the Word. Also we read constantly many fine Christian books which aides our study. We are so blessed in the United States of America with the wealth of religious freedom and godly teachers. That is why we must be faithful to take the meat of God's Word to those longing to know it. God dispels the darkness with the light of His Word and we are more convinced than ever that MINTOR MINISTRY is right on target as we teach and give Bibles. You are a vital part of this ministry because without your prayers we would not even attempt doing this. Isaiah 50:4 says, "The Sovereign Lord has given me an instructed tongue, to know the Word that sustains the weary."





## THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES!!

God is leading us to go to two new areas where evil and witchcraft have reigned for centuries. We are not fearful because the Apostle John wrote, "You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." Your prayers are key to spiritual victory and protection because Satan tries to prevent the truth of the Word of God knowing that the Word of truth will bring victory into the lives of those who hear and believe it.

In Ephesians 6 after Paul explained about arming yourself with the armor of God, he said and pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. We are going to give you as many details as we can in this letter but we trust you will pray however and whenever the Holy Spirit leads you. The first area is Meru, Kenya which is where witchcraft is so practiced. This is a town located on the east side of Mt. Kenya. The second area is Lira, Uganda located in north central Uganda. This is the area where the lord's resistance army was so active for so many years. It is near Gulu where so many of the invisible children are located.

Please pray for International Sports Federation who is taking a group into this area just prior to our coming. Please pray for them as they minister to these needy children. Pray for us as we minister to the pastors and wives who minister to these children on an ongoing basis.

One other challenge is we will be ministering to many of the pastors and wives who have recently gone through much tragedy, trials, and displacement due to the tribal unrest as a result of the national election. At each seminar in Kenya we will be sharing Gods Word in regard to their suffering and pain. Pray for Gods wisdom for us. (James 1.5)

Finally one last challenge we will face is the danger in travel on the roads, especially in Kenya. There is a gang of renegades who are very violent and rebellious to the government. This gang often stops vehicles on the roads and kills people for no reason. We have been advised to fly over one of the roads we usually drive because of this problem. This will add an extra expense to this mission but a necessary one. Also the price of food and fuel have gone up 400% since we were last there. We are trusting Gods provision. (II Corinthians 9:8)

Aug 3-Sun Worship/ travel by vehicle to Entebbe to fly to near Lira.

Aug 10-Sun Worship/travel to Nebbi, Uganda by vehicle (2 to 3 hrs.)

Aug 11-Mon Rest/study/reorganize/Meet with pastors.

Aug 12-13-Tues-Wed Teach Nebbi 2nd Series of Seminars. Pray against distractions, for good interpreters.

Aug 14-Thur Travel to Arua by vehicle about 2 hrs. drive.

Aug 15-16-Fri-Sat Teach 2<sup>nd</sup> Series of Bible Seminars. Pray for giving of the Bibles and reading glasses.

Aug 17-Sun Fly to Entebbe

Aug 18-Mon Pack and prepare to fly home. Pray that we will be rested before we fly home and that we do

not get sick on the flight.

Sometimes when we stop and think of what God is leading us to do, a huge cloud of fear and doubt raises its head. We will be in 11 different locations, giving out hundreds of Bible study materials to pastors who cherish every page. Then God says to give Bibles to each pastor to take to his church to give to people who cannot afford to have a Bible. Do you know how many Bibles that is? That is hundreds of Bibles and not just New Testaments but whole Bibles. Then the Lord is leading us to give reading glasses to help those who cannot read without glasses and who cannot afford them. We fall on our knees and say Lord this ministry is far beyond us and we look to you to provide. We are so humbled at the outpouring of glasses we have received. God just keeps providing, little by little. Our closets in the front bedroom are our ministry closets where we keep ties, scarves, and glasses and gifts to pack. Honestly it is amazing how when we pack, there is just exactly what we need to take. Truly this is a miraculous provision. Right now we again are far short of Bible money but we know that when we leave God will provide for the Bibles He wants given in the outer regions and poor areas of Kenya and Uganda.

We continue to claim, 2 Cor. 9.8-9 "God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. As it is written: "He has scattered abroad his gifts to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." Often God stirs my heart by asking me, "What if you did not have a Bible?"





## A RECENT MIRACLE!!

As we shared in our last letter, 1 of our 4 suitcases did not arrive with us from Malawi. It was Duanes and everything was replaceable except his cherished teaching Bible which had been rebound and contained lots of personal notes and promises received. We kept praying but to be honest after a month, we broke down and replaced some of the necessary clothing. We just kept praying God please just walk that Bible home. On the  $40^{th}$  day we received a call that it would be delivered.

The man delivering it said, "Sir Ive been delivering lost luggage a long time and have never before delivered one that was lost that long, this is a miracle." We fell on our knees and thanked God for walking that Bible home. Praise and thanks be to God and thank you who prayed for it. God does answer our prayers!

Thank you for covering us and this mission in prayer. Continue to pray for the upcoming work in East Asia. We will only be in a month between this work and when we leave on it.
