Ephesians 3.20 says, "Now to him who is able to do immeasurable more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen."

We have experienced a lot of spiritual warfare as we have prepared for this work which makes us anticipate even more what God is going to do. We want to give you the schedule so you can pray effectively. We are so grateful for your faithful prayers and support!



## **OBJECTIVE OF THIS MISSION**

To teach God's Word to Pastors and wives, evangelists, and church leaders in <u>SIX</u> cities (five in Malawi and one in Mozambique) with each seminar ranging from 2 to 4 days each. In each location we will be distributing Bibles to pastors and others who do not have one or whose Bible is worn out. We will also give each person attending the seminars a syllabus of Bible study materials.

Following are some prayer requests which you can pray that are needed throughout the mission work:



Pray that God would receive all the glory in all that we say or do and that there would be much spiritual fruit to His glory!

John 15.8a "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit," Psalm115.1 "Not to us, O Lord, not to us but to your Name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness."

Pray that the Word taught would fall on fertile soil (hungry, willing to learn and apply hearts) so that it will be reproduced.

Matthew 13:8 "Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop--a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown".

Pray that all teaching would be through the Holy Spirit's control and that everyone would have spiritual understanding.

I Corinthians 2.4,5 "My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power."

Pray for safety in travel both by air and by roads for us and for the pastor/coordinators. The work will take us traveling all over the country of Malawi and then West into the Tete area of Mozambique. We will be staying in six different guest houses. Pray for good rest at night.

Pray for protection from evil and from germs, and bad food that would make us sick and unable to do the work God has for us to do.

Pray for unity among the different denominations and leaders who will be working and serving in this mission.

Pray for wisdom and discernment to know how many Bibles to give to each place according to the needs. *James 1.5* 

Pray for the love of Jesus to continually flow through us. Romans 12.9a "Love must be sincere."

Pray that the Gospel presentations would be clear and that many would come to faith in Jesus Christ. *II Peter* 3.9

Pray that as we give out many gifts such as frameable family poems, books, scarves, pens, caps, and other small items at each session that God would bless each receiver.

Pray that we will have more insight and understanding of the people and culture to whom we will be teaching.

Colossians 1.9b "we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding."

Pray for our family while we are gone. (Especially Norma, Duane's 92 year old Mother).

Pray for consistent electrical power and for the overhead projector to work well.

Pray for spirit-filled interpreters who will be interpreting the Bible teaching.

Pray for our daily disciplines of time in the Word and in prayer because we will be giving out so much this must be a priority.

Pray that God would help us as we work out all the financial details (especially the last day in every location and just before we leave from Blantyre).
