We cannot express how valuable your prayers are to this ministry. Truly, prayer is the way God does His business on this earth. It is so exciting to experience His divine leading and intervention as we follow Him. The Advisory Board meeting in August went well and the ministry is moving forward. This is our tentative schedule for 2008:

February—March Malawi, Mozambique and S. Africa
July—August Kenya and Uganda
October—China

This will be a God sized task and we must begin preparation and provision for this now. In 1978 when the Lord called us into mission work we felt it would include China in some way. Now 30 years later God is sending us there. You will hear more about these missions later.

EL SALVADOR, CENTRAL AMERICA

El Salvador is the smallest country in Central America just a little smaller than the state of Massachusetts.



That means we will be able to travel by vehicle from one area to another. It is a country of around 7 million people with 35% of them living below the poverty level. They are a progressive, hard working and, beautiful people.

While Catholicism is the major religion there are over 1



million protestant Christians in the country. We are looking forward to seeing and working with old friends.

It is a country that has been hit hard by hurricanes, wars, and earthquakes.

Schedule

Sunday, Oct. 14 Fly to San Salvador, the capital. Monday, Oct. 15 Meet with coordinators and work on set up. Tuesday, Oct. 16 Duane and Deanna speak at a dinner meeting with around 300 doctors, and medical professionals. (asked to speak on the family). We will share the gospel and give an invitation. Pray Acts 26.17b & 18, "I am sending you to them to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me." Thursday/Friday Teach seminars at San Salvador Christian Campus from 8:30am to 3pm Oct. 18-19 (250 pastors and spouses) We will work with the missionary that heads this Bible School, Rev. Bob Kendrick. Saturday/Sunday Speak in churches in San Salvador. Oct. 20-2 We will also travel on Sunday a couple of hours south to San Miguel. Psalm 91.9 "If you make the Most High your dwelling—even the Lord, who is my refuge—then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent." Monday-Wed. San Miguel Teaching seminars 8:30am - 3:30pm each day (300 pastors & wives) Oct.22,23,24 I Cor. 2.13, "This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, expressing spiritual truths in spiritual words." Pray that God would heal broken relationships. This seminar reaches pastors from Usulutan and the southern regions also. Thursday-Sat. Rest, regroup, organize, and meet with the pastor/coordinating committees. Oct. 25-27 Sunday Oct. 28 Speak in churches. Pray that people will come to know Jesus as their personal Savior. John 1.12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God--Monday Oct. 29 Travel from San Miguel to Santa Ana about $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours. TuesdayOThursday Santa Ana teach seminars from 12 noon to 8pm with a break for dinner. Oct. 30-Nov. 1 This is the northern area of El Salvador where it is more rural. Pray that we will teach through the power of the Holy Spirit. Ephes. 5.18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

Friday Nov. 2 Conclude all financial obligations and meet with coordinating committee.

Saturday Nov. 3 Travel back to San Salvador.

Sunday Nov. 4 Fly back to Oklahoma City
